## School Mission Statement

The mission of R. M. Moore Elementary School is to provide a community in which students have opportunities to be academically, emotionally, socially and physically productive. A variety of learning experiences will be provided which will challenge and motivate the spectrum of the students' abilities.

## School Improvement Goal 1

The percentage of 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students scoring at the Proficient and Distinguished Learner Levels in ELA will increase from 30% to 39% by May 2025, with a 3% increase during the 2023, 2024 and 2025 school years as measured by the Georgia Milestones ELA Assessment.

## School Improvement Goal 2

The percentage of 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students scoring at the Proficient and Distinguished Learner Levels in Math will increase from 39% to 48% by May 2025, with a 3% increase during the 2023, 2024 and 2025 school years as measured by the Georgia Milestones Math Assessment.
