## School Mission Statement

Woodstock Elementary School is committed to provide a positive environment in which students advance academically, emotionally, physically, and socially in a challenging learning environment. We will provide a strong progressive Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) focus in a culturally responsive setting to maximize learning in the 21st century.

### School Improvement Goal 1

Improve reading achievement in 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students as measured by the GA Milestones during the 2017 to 2019 school years to decrease the number of students who are scoring below grade level in reading by 3% annually.

### School Improvement Action Plan

- Utilize **Guided Reading Instruction** in Kindergarten through 5th grades.
- Implement daily **Phonics Instruction** grades K-3, in the Early Intervention Program and English Language Learner reading classes.
- Use **RCD Units with Professional Learning** support of Instructional Lead Strategist.

### School Improvement Goal 2

Improve writing achievement as measured by the GA Milestones during the 2017 to 2019 school years to decrease the number of 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students who are scoring in the remediation range in writing and language by 3% annually.

### School Improvement Action Plan

- Use **Concept Mapping** to further develop writing skills.
- Instruct students to **Self-Evaluate** their writing with grade-level state writing rubric.
- Provide individual **Feedback to Students** on their writing with grade-level state writing rubric.
