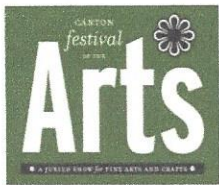

Rules and Application

Children of all ages are invited to participate in the *Chalk Walk; Street Chalk Art Display* held during the Canton Festival of the Arts. Squares will be assigned to each participant who will then create works of art. The art will be on display during the festival. Proceeds will benefit the Cherokee Arts Center.

Location: Brown Park in historic downtown Canton GA, Saturday, May 4, 2019. Check-in is located at the festival information tent located in the center of the park.

Fees: Postmarked on or before April 19, 2019 - \$10.00 Postmarked after April 19, 2019 and day of the event -\$15.00

Mail application and check to: Canton Chalk Walk, P.O. Box 965296, Marietta, GA 30066.

Make check payable to Cherokee Arts Center. Check must accompany the registration form.

Material Restrictions: One box of sidewalk chalk will be provided for each pre-registered participant. Participants may bring their own chalk, brushes and water. Chalk must be water-based. No other special paints, chinks, or additives may be used. ALL supplies must be presented at check-in for inspection.

Space Assignments: Spaces (roughly a 3 ft. square) are given out randomly on a first-come, first-serve basis. Some spaces may have cracks and color or texture variations.

Check-In and Registration: Begins at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, May 4 and will remain open until 3:00 p.m. Day of registration is permitted as long and space is available and chalk will be provided as long as supplies last.

In Case of Rain: If cancelled due to inclement weather, participants can pick up their box of chalk at the festival's Information tent) anytime during the festival hours (10:00 – 5:00 p.m.). Call 404-966-8497 if weather is questionable. No refunds will be issued.
