❖ Teacher-Parent-Student Compact Grade 1 ❖

The Cherokee County School District Goal for Student Achievement states:

- ◆ Increase the number of students in grades 3rd through 5th scoring at level 3 and/or level 4 by 3% on the Georgia Milestones ELA End-of-Grade assessment by the end of the 2019-20 school year.
- ◆ Increase the number of EL students in grades 3rd through 12th scoring at level 3 by 3% on the Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade/End-of-Course assessments in all subjects by the end of the 2019-20 school year.

So what is our goal?

R.M. Moore will increase the percentage of students scoring at the Proficient or Distinguished levels from 55% to 64% in the area of ELA as measured by the GA Milestones with a 3% increase each year during the 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years for an overall gain of 9%.

- ◆ This goal will be applied to all grade levels as preparation for the Milestones Assessment begins as early as Kindergarten.

Teachers

The team will work with students and families to support student success in the following ways:

- ◆ Will ensure that every student regularly brings home books on their independent reading level from our school Media Center or classroom libraries to read nightly.
- ◆ Will provide a weekly log activity for parents and students to complete as they are reading with their students at least 15 minutes per night.
- ◆ Will provide weekly optional homework activities for parents and students to complete in order to earn classroom prizes
