School Improvement Year 1 Action Plan

- Utilize **Direct Reading Instruction** in Kindergarten through 5th grades.
- Implement Daily Phonics Instruction.
- Use **Concept Mapping** to further develop reading comprehension.

School Improvement Goal 2

Improve writing achievement as measured by the GA Milestones during the 2017 to 2019 school years to decrease the number of 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students who are scoring in the remediation range in writing and language by 3% annually.
